

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

TOBIQUE FIRST NATION as represented by Chief Stewart Paul (Hereinafter referred to by "First Nation")

and

PROVINCE OF NEW BRUNSWICK as represented by the Minister of Aboriginal Affairs Secretariat; (Hereinafter referred to as the "Province")

MISSION STATEMENT

This Agreement is the first step in establishing a positive relationship between Tobique First Nation and the Province of New Brunswick

DEFINITION

"Party" or "Parties" in this Agreement refers to the First Nation and /or Province.

PRIORITIES AGREED UPON (refer to Appendix 1)

Whereas the Province and NB Power have agreed that they will provide remediation to the First Nation for the Erosion along the St. John and Tobique Rivers, AND

Whereas the Province and NB Power have agreed that they will provide remediation to the First Nation in respect of dump site contamination, AND

Whereas the Province and the First Nation desire to enter into discussions and agreements, Chief and Council and the Province will refer to the existing Action Team and appropriate provincial department and/or agency to plan, negotiate, and resolve the following items including but not limited to:

- Remediation for the Erosion along St. John and Tobique Rivers
- Investigation, Assessment and Remediation of dump site contamination
- Electric Energy Development Opportunities
- Training and Mentorship Program, learning maintenance activities in a hydro electrical station including Tobique Dam and Beechwood. This activity will include the normal maintenance activities related to the safe and efficient delivery of electricity
- Royalties
- 5 mega watt power generation for the Band
- Other Tobique Dam issues including but not limited to:
 - Power lines
 - Ownership
 - Leases
